



# North West Leicestershire Let's Get Moving Awards (Sport and Health Awards)

## Criteria for awards 2022

These nominations are for achievements and successes within the qualifying period between October 2021 to September 2022. Nominees must be located in or train within North West Leicestershire.

### Let's Get Moving School Award

This award is for primary or secondary schools that have achieved and can demonstrate sporting success or increasing participation in sport and physical activity and creating sport for all across the school. Nominees should also engage with community sport and create strong links with local clubs.

### Primary School Team of the Year

This award is for a primary school team that has achieved outstanding competitive success whilst showing strong team spirit and fair play.

### Secondary School Team of the Year

This award is for a secondary school team that has achieved outstanding competitive success whilst showing strong team spirit and fair play.

### Team of the Year

This award is for a team that has displayed excellence in their sport. The team should demonstrate dedication and commitment, including coaches and others involved in supporting the team. Professional or community sports teams are eligible for nomination in this category.

### Club of the Year

This award is for a club that has demonstrated commitment to the development of the members of their club, including participants, coaches and volunteers. The club must have engaged well with their local community and have an effective management structure which will sustain the club in the future. Nominees may have widened access to their sport to include people who do not normally have the opportunity to take part, engaging people from 'hard to reach' groups.

### Sportsperson of the Year

This award is for a sportsperson of any age who has excelled and / or exceeded all expectations in their performances. Examples of local, county, regional, national, and international competitions entered with placings required.

### Disabled Sportsperson of the Year

This award is for a sportsperson of any age with a learning and / or physical disability who has shown resilience and determination to participate or excelled in their sport. Examples of acting as a role model to club members or the community.

### Activator of the Year

This award recognises an individual or group who have had positive impact on others as a result of giving their time, either coaching, volunteering or officiating, within sport and physical activity. Nominees may be considered an inspiration and positive role model to encourage more people to start, stay and succeed in physical activity or sport and have built strong relationships and links with clubs, schools and / or other community organisations.

### Let's Get Moving for Health

This award is for any individual who has taken steps towards a healthy lifestyle by becoming more physically active to actively improve their mental and physical health and wellbeing, manage long term medical conditions or to prevent ill health.

### Outstanding contribution

This special award recognises an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to sport and physical activity in North West Leicestershire over a number of years. Showing exceptional commitment – a real unsung hero. They will have 'gone over and above' the call of duty. A true role model for others. Not restricted to the timeframe.
